Information for Parents/Guardians

Dear Parent,

We hope that this note will help inform and advise the Parents and Guardians of our Junior and Vulnerable Adult Members. Foiled Again takes the Welfare and Safety of the members attending our fencing club very seriously.

Our Child Protection and Anti-Bullying Policy is the same as that of the British Fencing Association and it is the club's policy to be open to the parents of all children attending the club.

Should you have any concerns on the day of training please contact Mr Ian Toplis, Chairman and Coach, on 07804 631945.

The Club's elected Welfare Officer is Mrs Jane Mason. Should you have any issues/concerns that need addressing please kindly contact Jane in the first instance.

Our Head Coach is Mr Mick Dennis, who is British Fencing registered and a qualified level 3 coach at Foil, level 2 coach at Epee and Sabre standard. Mick has also been DBS certified and is an approved coach, listed on the British Fencing child protection register

Additional Club coaches are: Mr Ian Toplis, Mr Alan Bown and Miss Harriet Wheeler. All our coaches are British Fencing Qualified and all DBS/ Child protection Certified. Additionally, all have attended Welfare training sessions and have received Level One child protection qualifications.

Foiled Again respectfully requests that all Parents/Guardians of children attending the classes abide by the following mandatory rules:

- 1. The Main Door is kept locked at all times and only a club officer is to open the door.
- Parents to stay at the Club during their child's training session and to only leave their child unattended with the prior agreement of the Coaches.
- No child will be released to people other than those identified to the coaches.
- 4. All parents <u>must</u> leave a contact Telephone number with the Club.
- 5. Parents who wish to meet their children outside the venue <u>must</u> give us written permission to allow the children out.
- 6. Any injury sustained during fencing will be logged and Parents notified.

- 8. From time to time photographs for coaching purposes will be taken to enhance our coaching and your child's understanding of the moves taught. Only Parents/Guardians of the children involved shall has access to these images and they will not be used for publicity material without your written permission to do so.
